



California Women for Agriculture North Valley Chapter 2019 Scholarship Application

The California Women for Agriculture North Valley Chapter annually awards scholarships to Northern California students pursuing careers in agriculture. Since 2000, the North Valley Chapter has awarded more than \$50,000 in scholarships to high school seniors and university students through its scholarship program. Scholarship amounts and number of recipients vary each year, though the North Valley Chapter makes approximately ten awards in amounts ranging from \$250 to \$1,000.



Application Instructions

1. Eligible applicants include graduating high school seniors and students attending colleges located in Butte, Glenn, Tehama, Shasta, Siskiyou, Lassen, Shasta, Plumas, Yuba, Colusa and Sutter Counties, or a student who is a child or grandchild of a member of our Chapter.
2. No handwritten applications will be accepted.
3. Applications must be postmarked by **April 13, 2019**. No emailed applications will be accepted. All applications must be submitted to:

4. All applications must include an unofficial transcript from applicant's high school or college.
5. All applicants must submit a resume highlighting school activities, awards and achievements, community involvement, and work experience.
6. All applications must include one current signed letter of recommendation. Letters may be submitted from a teacher, college professor, community member, employer, pastor, etc.
7. Preference will be given to first time applicants, applicants showing financial need, and applicants studying an agricultural or related field.
8. No late or incomplete applications will be accepted for consideration.
9. Please paper clip all application materials.
10. Successful award recipients will be required to submit official documentation signed by the school's registrar confirming enrollment. Scholarship funds will not be released until this documentation is submitted. **Awarded funds must be claimed within one academic year.**
